The Kern Family Health Care Health Homes Program offers new, no-cost services to help members with certain chronic conditions get the health care and community services you need. When you join this program, you will have your own care team to support you as you work toward your health goals.

Get the Care You Need



What is the Health Homes Program?

This no-cost program serves members with complex chronic health conditions, like diabetes, hypertension or substance use disorder. If you qualify, the program has a care team to provide supportive services to address your needs, including:

- Physical health
- Behavioral health
- Substance use treatment

Your care team can also help you:

- Find Doctors and set up appointments
- Set up transportation for health visits
- Get follow-up services after you leave the hospital
- Manage all your medicines

How can the program help you?

You get your own care team, which includes a physician and these trained professionals:

- Nurse Care Manager
- Behavioral Health Care Manager
- Care Coordinator
- Community Health Worker

Your care team works with all your Providers and your personal support system to create a personalized care plan just for you.

Your care team will help you:

- Keep all your Providers fully informed
- Set goals for getting and staying healthy
- Find and apply for county and community services, like food, housing, jobs, child care, legal, and more

Get more services

Joining the Health Homes Program will not change any benefits you now have. You can keep your current Doctor and Specialists, plus get:

- Your own care team
- A personal care plan
- Guidance through the medical process
- Be rewarded for keeping scheduled appointments

These services are at no cost, and you can join or stop the program at any time.

Support when you need it

Your care team can support you by phone or in person at health centers near you. We may even go to your home. You'll never feel alone with the Health Homes Program.

Who is eligible?

The Health Homes Program is for members with certain complex chronic health conditions who meet specific criteria.
